### Autumn Leaves XXXVIII 2023 Covid Information

We know there is no 100% assurance of safety from Covid or other disease transmission at our gathering. We want you to have fun and for all of us to be as safe as possible! In that spirit, we offer the following suggestions.

- Though not required, vaccinations with boosters are strongly encouraged.
- A Covid test on the day of arrival to Autumn Leaves 38 is encouraged.
- Development of Covid symptoms (sore throat, nasal congestion, cough, fever, etc.), or a positive Covid test just before or during the Autumn Leaves workshop is reason to stay away.
- A refund of registration fees will be available for anyone unable to attend because they developed Covid or tested positive just before or during the workshop.
- Masking, covering both nose and mouth, as well as frequent handwashing and sanitizing, are encouraged, particularly for immunocompromised people. NIFD will provide hand sanitizer and extra masks for those who need them.
- Snacks will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own snacks. We ask that everyone bring their own water containers and drinks.
